A magnificent estate in a dreamlike countryside: The castle hotel Burg Schlitz in Mecklenburg-West Pomerania is regarded as a leading name for all people who are looking for relaxation in a breath-taking countryside or those who are simply going to hold a conference in a stylish and isolated ambience. The elegant residence has 20 individually equipped rooms and suites and is located far away from daily hectic pace in an area with 180 hectares nearby Rostock.

Almost two centuries ago it was built by Friedrich Adam Leiblin by order of Count Hans of Schlitz. From 1992 to 1999 it was carefully and costly restored and renovated, and newly opened as a castle hotel in 1999. The decor and furnishings reflect the great heritage of the castle. The rooms are individually unique, with antiques and made-to-measure furnishings in Biedermeier style from the German workshops Hellerau, Dresden. Valuable Bedouin and silk wares replenish each room with its special color design and oiled floorboards provide a very special experience. Enjoy the unmistakable flair of the gourmet-restaurant in the Knight's hall! Framed with indirect lighting by a multitude of candles on culinary events or flooded with light during celebrations, parties or for the evening - simply the perfect place for culinary delights! The very best from regional French and Italian cuisine combined with spices and Indonesian culinary style - represents the extraordinary and unmistakable cuisine of Thomas Kilgore, host and chef at Burg Schlitz.

As a visitor and guest of Burg Schlitz you will find silence and relaxation in an unspoiled countryside. Wide avenues, hidden ponds and idyllic places invite you to go for a walk or even on a picnic, which the hotel can provide for you. Scattered around the park, you will find numerous obelisks and monuments that were erected by Count Schlitz in memory of his family and friends. However, the jewel of the park is the Nymph fountain that was built in 1903 by Walter Schott, in the Nouveau period. The area around the magnificent estate, with its unique park in Mecklenburg-West Pomerania, is one of the oldest scenes for hunting on horseback behind the pack. In the summer of 2004 the royal stables were restored and exploring the countryside by horseback is once again possible.
